Yellow = well-being


Interventions

Overview: provision of TA time to deliver intervention programmes to support small groups and individual children. Use of TAs to provide 'top up' sessions.

Cost £23,700

Aim/outcomes:

To accelerate rates of progress in all core subjects across all year groups.



Accelerated Reader

Overview: License, training and books purchase

Cost £ 1,590

Aim/outcomes:

Increased confidence (discussion)
Increased attainment in Reading, Writing (Assessment Data) and improved engagement with books and school library. Encourage more parental support.

Service Agreements with Outside Agencies and Partners

Overview: To enhance pastoral support with additional resources from SW Families, Babcock Ed Psych service and SENDCO.

Cost: £ 28,500

Aim/Outcomes:

Ability to respond quickly to pupils needs and needs within the family and provide a holistic solution for home and school.

Breakfast/Afterschool Care

Overview: Free places to enable parents to attend meetings and school functions

Cost: £ 50

Aim/Outcomes:

Increased attendance at key meetings such as curriculum sessions and parent teacher meetings

Uniform Provision

Overview: School Uniform provided for those in most need.

Cost: £50

Aim/Outcomes:

To promote a sense of well-being and belonging to the school community through quality uniform provision

TEAM Room

Overview: To provide a special space for children experiencing challenges and a room to engage with parents.

Aim/Outcomes:

Room recognized as a safe space for talking, group work and meetings.


Pupil/Parent Support Worker

Overview: Differentiated tutorial sessions with individuals. Emotional well-being support.

Cost: £21,984

Extra-Curricular – Music and PE clubs

Overview: Specialist music teacher and PE coach used to provide after school clubs

Cost: £200

Aims/outcomes: To provide an opportunity and equal access for all children to engage in specialist teaching sessions.

Forest School/Gardening/cooking

Overview: Monies available to support children in developing their social engagement in a practical context.

Cost: £250

Aims/outcomes: To provide practical and physical learning where children work in groups and develop their social skills.

Gifted and Talented programme


Overview: Opportunities to engage in G and T drama involving professional company. Exeter University G and T maths courses.

Cost: £200

Aim/Outcomes: Raise aspiration. Increased self esteem.

Blue = Enrichment/engagement

Subsidised Trips

Overview: School trips and residential subsidised by 50% to ensure access for all pupils.

Cost: £1750

Aim/Outcomes:

Raise aspiration, motivation and engagement.
Secure equal opportunity.

Swimming Lessons

Overview: Pupils have the opportunity to learn to swim and develop water confidence.

Cost: £800

Aim/Outcomes:

- Increase self-esteem and improved motor skills.
- To provide an essential life skill.

Music Tuition

Overview: Pupils given opportunity to learn a musical instrument using specialist teachers. Cost includes hire of instruments if necessary or subsidized purchases.

Cost: £200

Aim/Outcomes: Improved self-esteem. Engagement in ensembles. Awareness of another avenue.
