ANIMAL SAFARI

In the Animal Safari project, the children will learn about incredible animals that live worldwide. They will explore various animal habitats and compare the animals that live there with animals in their locality. We will have an exciting visit from Exmoor Zoo!

They will learn how to care for pets and what all animals need to grow, survive and stay happy and healthy. They will explore animal features and find out how they survive in the wild. They will compare the ways that animals are similar and different such as which ones have fur, feathers or scales.

We will be finding out how many children will fit along the length of an anaconda and walking the length of a blue whale on the field. We will see if we can move like animals and make some animal masks.



BIG WIDE WORLD

In the Big Wide World project, your child will find out about the world in which they live. They will learn about different climates and explore habitats, including their flora and fauna. They will locate the United Kingdom on a world map and compare life in the United Kingdom with life elsewhere. They will also learn about caring for their environment, both locally and beyond.

We will also be helping your child with the following :-

Maths - Number recognition, number patterns, counting, place value and ordering.

Physical Development - We will have exercise every day and coaching from Exeter City each week.

Personal, social, emotional development - Self regulation, sharing toys, building relationships, what makes a good friend.

The World - Caring for animals, people and their communities,

Exploring Art & Design - Mark making, using lots of different art materials,

Communication & Listening - Listening to others, attention and understanding, taking in turns to speak and using good manners.

Literacy - Listening to stories, begin to recognise some phonic sounds and writing the sounds they know.
